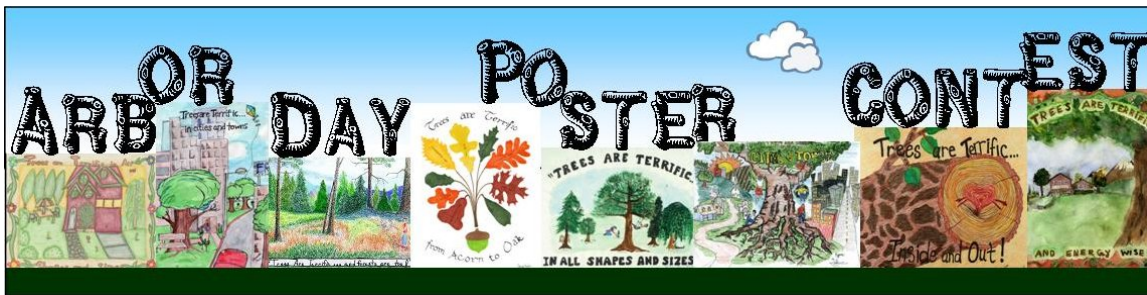


## Attention 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Students in the Allen ISD!

- ✓ 2023 Theme: **“Trees are Terrific...inside and out!”**
- ✓ 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grade students in the Allen ISD may create a poster no smaller than 8 ½” x 11” and no larger than 14” x 18” that reflects their understanding of the environmental benefits and products that trees provide. Remember that this is an informational poster and it is highly encouraged to label parts of the tree and include written facts. It is also highly recommended that students review the Activity Guide located at <https://www.cityofallen.org/974/KAB-Education-Outreach>. Please do not follow the instructions for creating a poster located in the back of the Activity Guide. Instead use these instructions and the Rubric (judging sheet)!
- ✓ Don't forget to include the theme on the poster and write your first and last name in the lower right-hand corner on the front of the poster. Complete the Entry Form.
- ✓ **Take a picture of the poster and email it, along with the Entry Form, to [ContestKAB@gmail.com](mailto:ContestKAB@gmail.com) by 5:00 pm on February 10, 2023.**
- ✓ One 1<sup>st</sup> place winner will receive a 3” caliper, 6’ shade tree planted at their school or in a city park in their honor in March or April. The 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners will be honored by Keep Allen Beautiful, the Mayor and City Council at a City Council meeting in February or March. Gift cards to Target will also be presented: 1<sup>st</sup> place = \$20, 2<sup>nd</sup> place = \$15, 3<sup>rd</sup> place = \$10.
